In view of the amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, the order of interim injunction passed by the Co-operative Court stands vacated, subject to condition of the Petitioners depositing the amount of Rs.14,00,000/- with Respondent No.2-Society within a period of eight weeks from today, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of both the parties.

3. Writ Petition is disposed of in the above terms, with a further direction to the Co-operative Court to decide the dispute between the parties as expeditiously as possible and preferably by 31st December, 2018.

4. Needless to state that, the warrant of attachment, which is already issued, becomes infructuous in view of disposal of the Writ Petition.
