This Application is moved by the applicant/wife for restoration of Miscellaneous Civil Application, which was dismissed by the conditional order dated 10th April, 2017 passed by the Registrar (Judicial-II).

The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that this Court by order dated 15th February, 2017 has issued notice to the respondent, however, for furnishing the copies of appeal memo, conditional order of dismissal was passed on 10th April, 2017 by Registrar (Judicial-II).
