Heard Mr.Vishal Kanade, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Chirag Balsara, learned counsel for respondents No.1, 2, 5 to 8, Mr.Himanshu Kode, learned counsel for respondent No.9, Mr. Arvind Aswani, learned counsel for respondent No.10, Ms. Rukmini Thokal, learned counsel for respondents No.11 to 21 and Mr. G.W. Mattos, learned counsel for respondent No.22, at length.

3. This Petition can conveniently be disposed of by granting limited protection till 7.12.2018. Mr. Mattos states that the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee (for short, 'Committee') is meeting on 7.12.2018. The petitioner should file an application for interim relief in the meantime and serve copy on all the affected parties. On 7.12.2018, the Committee shall consider granting ad-interim relief prayed by the petitioner. If for any reason the Committee is not in a position to take up the matter on that date, it will suitably pass ad-interim relief so as to protect the petitioner's interest and fix the matter as per its convenience. Till 7.12.2018, the impugned order dated 24.9.2018 is stayed.

4. Application for ad-interim relief shall be considered on its own merits and in accordance with law. Granting of the relief shall not be construed as an expression of merits either way. All contentions of the parties are expressly kept open. Subject to this, the petition is disposed of. Order accordingly.
