

from the date of filing the concerned Application in consideration to the aim and object of the SARFAESI Act and be further pleased to direct the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to dispose of the Applications as per Annexure immediately;”

2. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that there were four Applications viz. Case Nos. 248/2017, 249/2017, 568/2017 and 554/2017, pending for disposal before the District Magistrate/Collector of Pune at the time of filing of this Petition.

3. In these circumstances, considering the mandate of Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act to decide such Applications within 30 days and in any event, not later than 60 days, we direct Respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid Applications at the earliest as per the mandate of the Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act.

4. In future too, it is expected of the Respondent No.2 not to keep such Applications pending beyond 60 days at the highest.

5. Writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
