ORDER :

1. The learned Counsel appearing for the 1st

Respondent states on instruction of Ms. Meenal Palande, Sports Officer, Thane Municipal Corporation that the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) has been approved by the General Body of the 1st Respondent in the meeting held on 20th May 2018. A copy of the SOP is also placed on record. It is taken on record and marked as “**S1**” for identification.

2. Therefore, the only substantive prayer which is the prayer clause (c) is worked out. Therefore, nothing survives in the Petition and the Civil Application. Accordingly, the Writ Petition and the Civil Application are disposed of.

3. We however, make it clear that no adjudication is made on legality and validity of the SOP and the decision adopting SOP. If the Petitioner is aggrieved by the same, he can always adopt an appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
