In respect of the reliefs claimed in this petition, the Petitioner already filed representation dated 23rd August, 2016 before Collector of Stamps, Enforcement, Mumbai. This representation is not decided. The learned counsel for the Petitioner having taken instructions, states that petition may be disposed of by directing Collector of Stamps, Enforcement to decide the said representation on its own merits.
