2. By this notice of motion, the applicant seeks condonation of delay in filing notice of motion and has prayed for setting aside the order dated 15th July, 2014 passed by the learned Prothonotary and Senior Master.

3. I have heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and have perused the affidavit in support of the notice of motion. The applicant has sufficiently explained the delay in filing the notice of motion and for not removing the office objections within the time prescribed.
