ORDER :

1. This Appeal under Section 35G of Central Excise Act, 1944 challenges the order dated 5th August 2005 passed by Customs, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal.

2. This Appeal was admitted on 4th October 2007.
3. The instructions / circular dated 11th July 2018 issued by the Central Board of Indirect Tax and Customs directs the Revenue not to file fresh Appeals and also withdraw the pending Appeals where the tax effect is less than Rs. 50.00 Lakhs.
4. In the above view, Shri. Bangur, learned counsel appearing in support of the Appeal, on instructions of Shri. C. Dhanashekar, Commissioner, (CGST & CX), Thane, seeks to withdraw the Appeal.
5. Accordingly, the Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
