1. Accepted. The Petitioner is the widow of the deceased. She is the only heir of the deceased. They had no sons or daughters. Hence, proclamation dispensed with. The Petition is made returnable forthwith and taken up for hearing and final disposal.
2. The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Madhukar Pandurang Vidyasagar, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 13th September 2017. A copy of his death certificate is annexed.

3. At the time of his death, the deceased was resident at 124, Palan Sojpal Building No. B, SK Bole Marg, Dadar (West), Mumbai 400 028.
4. The Petitioner is the only surviving legal heir of the deceased.
5. The Legal Heirship Certificate is required for the purposes of production before the Income-tax authorities.
6. No other Petition for a Heirship Certificate, Succession Certificate, Probate or Letters of Administration with or without will annexed has been filed. There is no impediment to the grant of relief.
7. The petition is made absolute in terms of prayer clause (a) in favour of the Petitioner.
8. Certificate to be issued expeditiously.
