1. By my order dated 6th April 2018 I requested Mr Farhan Dubash to serve as a Commissioner to record the evidence and statement of one Hemant Samanta of Jewalex India Private Limited. The Registry will ensure that this dispatch is through a reputed courier service such as UPS, Fedex or Blue Dart/DHL.

4. The Plaintiffs' attorneys are requested to make the necessary arrangements for reimbursement directly to Mr Dubash of the expenses he has incurred and to pay his professional fees. In addition they will reimburse the High Court Registry for the costs of the courier.
