1 Registry has placed a report stating that pursuant to order dated 22.1.2018, respondent had published a notice of dismissal in two newspapers viz. 'Free Press Journal' in English and in 'Navshakti' in Marathi, on 24.1.2018 and filed affidavit of publication on 1.2.2018 and the registry has not received any affidavit opposing the dismissal of petition.

Within 4 weeks, petitioner shall commence the proceedings and notify Prothonotary & Senior Master accordingly under advise to the advocate for respondent.
