1. The Petition was accepted on 30th October 2017 when the proclamation was dispensed with.

2. The Petitioner seeks a Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of one Shyam Appa Kerlekar, who is said to have died intestate in Mumbai, where he was ordinarily resident, on 2nd November 2016. A copy of his death certificate is annexed. The deceased was survived by his widow and two sons. Their names are mentioned in the tabulation below paragraph 4 of the petition.

3. The Legal Heirship Certificate is required for transfer of the tenanted property at Shilpa Shree building Sion Chunabhatti Road, Mumbai 400 022.
