Learned Counsel for the Petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to approach the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee [erstwhile the High Power Committee] constituted under section 35(1A)(b) of the Maharashtra Slum Areas (Improvement, Clearance & Redevelopment) Act, 1971 to redress his grievance raised in the writ petition.
