For reasons set out in the Affidavit in support of the Chamber Summons, the same is allowed and the Court Receiver, High Court, Bombay is discharged without passing any accounts but upon payment of his costs, charges and expenses, by the Petitioner in respect of the mortgaged property being Plot No.6 (Old Block No.3) Station Road, Dewas-455001, more particularly described in Exhibit D to the Petition. However, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to take out a fresh Petition under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking the same reliefs if so advised. The Chamber Summons is accordingly disposed of.
