- (i) We accept the aforesaid statements made by the second respondent. The Municipal Corporation shall take action of demolition as expeditiously as possible in accordance with law;
- (ii) If action is not taken within reasonable time, the petitioner can always make a representation to the Municipal Corporation;
- (iii) The Petition is disposed of on above terms.
