(i) Ms. Nelly Mehta, Advocate, is appointed as the Sole Arbitrator to decide the disputes between the parties arising out of the Loan-cum-Hypothecation Agreement dated 24th February, 2014.

(ii) The parties and/or their Advocates shall appear before the learned Arbitrator in her Chambers on 27th April, 2018 at 5.00 p.m., and obtain necessary directions.

(iii) All contentions of the parties are kept open.

(iv) The cost of arbitration shall initially be borne by the parties equally.

(v) The venue of the arbitration shall be at Mumbai.

(vi) The Advocate for the Applicant shall forward a copy of this order to

Ms. Nelly Mehta, Advocate. A copy of the order shall also be forwarded to the Respondents by Speed Post/Registered Post A.D. at their last known addresses.

(vii) The above Arbitration Application is accordingly disposed of.
