1. The Petition for leave under Clause XII of the Letters Patent is filed in a Commercial Arbitration Petition under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (“**Arbitration Act**”).

2. The 1st Respondent is the Award Debtor. It is said to have assets within the jurisdiction of this Court including an amount owed by the 2nd Respondent to the 1st Respondent, and which lies in the bank accounts in Mumbai. There is, however, another asset which is outside the territorial jurisdiction of this Court but is in the
