1 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2 By this Petition, under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India, the Petitioners are challenging the order
dated 14.08.2018 passed by the Debt Recovery Tribunal-II,
Mumbai, below interim application no. 926 of 2018.

3 During the course of arguments, the learned
counsel for the Petitioners submits that the Petitioners had
already filed an Appeal before the Debt Recovery Appellate

Tribunal, Mumbai and the same is pending for hearing on its own merits.
