1. This Appeal relates to Assessment Year
2007-08.

2. Ms. Gokhale, Learned Counsel appearing for
the Revenue invited our attention to Circular No.3 of
2018 dated 11th July, 2018 issued by the Central Board
for Direct Tax (CBDT). The above Circular directs the

Officers of the Revenue not to file appeals to the High Court where the tax effect does not exceed Rs.50 lakhs. It also directs its Officers to withdraw/not press its pending appeals where the tax effect is less than Rs.50 lakhs. This, of course, if it does not fall in the excluded class of appeals listed therein.

3. In view of the Circular No.3 of 2018 dated 11th July, 2018 issued by the CBDT, Ms. Gokhale, Learned Counsel appearing for the Revenue, on instructions of Mr. S.S. Rane, Commissioner of Income-Tax-5, seeks to withdraw this Appeal.

4. Accordingly, Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
