Having regard to the aforesaid, we dispose of this petition by directing the the Competent Authority of the respondents to consider and take appropriate decision on the petitioner's representation and make the payments as may be found due to her as expeditiously as possible, but not later than three months from the date receipt of this order.

6. With the above directions, the petition stands disposed of.
