1 Mr.Noor Shergill, Assistant Official Liquidator leaves it to the court. I have perused the application and the affidavit in support. Though the explanation for delay is not very convincing, here is a case in which the applicant is having a decree against the company in liquidation. Therefore, I am inclined to condone the delay subject to some terms.

2 Application allowed in terms of prayer clause-(a) which reads as under :-

“(a) That delay of 986 days in lodging claim/submitting the Affidavit of Proof of Debts of Allahabad Bank (Exh.A hereto) with Official Liquidator, High Court, Bombay be condoned.”

3 Applicant to pay sum of Rs.10,000/- as costs. This amount to be paid by way of cheque drawn in favour of Official Liquidator to be used for office expenses of the Official Liquidator.

4 Official Liquidator to consider the affidavit of proof of debt of the applicant and dispose the same in accordance with law.

5 Application accordingly disposed.
