3. The learned AGP for the respondent state that the proposal forwarded has been rejected by the concerned department of the State Government.

4. According to Shri Parchure, learned counsel, this defence aggravates the contempt. He invites attention to the order dated 21.06.2017 passed in writ petition to urge that there unequivocal fact that the petitioner is entitled to advantage of stagnation has been brought on record.

7. In this situation, keeping all contentions of the petitioner open and with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the decision of the State Government on merits as per law, we dispose of the present Contempt petition with no order as to costs.
