- 2 The applicant is convicted for offence punishable under section 294, 506-I, 509 of the Indian Penal Code and under section 3([1][x] of the Scheduled Casts and

Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and is sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for three years for offence under section 3([1][x] of the Scheduled Casts and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

3 I have scrutinized the depositions of witnesses and the reasoning recorded by the learned Sessions Judge.

4 The sentence is suspended by the learned Special Judge.

5 Having scrutinized the record, I deem it appropriate to suspend the substantive sentence till the disposal of the appeal.

6 Bail as in trial Court.

7 The applicant – accused shall not, in any event and for any reason, establish any contact with the complainant. Needless to say, any infringement of this condition shall result in cancellation of bail.
