Since this Court was not inclined to allow the application, the learned Counsel for the applicant Shri R.K. Tiwari seeks leave to withdraw the application unconditionally with a request that the trial be expedited.

2. The application is disposed of as withdrawn unconditionally.

3. Since the trial is for offence punishable under Sections 376(2)(f),(i),(j), 354-A(i), 354-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 5(l),(m), 6, 9(m) and 10 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, it is even otherwise necessary for the trial Court to expeditiously decide the trial.

4. The learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within six months. If the trial is not concluded

within six months, the applicant shall be entitled to move for bail on the ground of delay in trial.
