**Criminal Application (APPW) No.95/2018:**

For reasons recorded while allowing the application for condonation of delay, the application for

restoration is allowed. However, the restoration is subject to the condition that the learned counsel shall supply copies for service on respondents within 48 hours. Needless to say, if the copies are not supplied in the stipulated period the order of restoration shall stand revoked.
