2. Civil Application is filed by the original respondent nos. 1 and 2 in Writ Petition No.258/2014, decided by this Court with other connected matters on 13.04.2018. Clarification is sought on the meaning of or scope of exercise to be undertaken in the light of the directions contained in paragraph nos. 63, 64, 65 and

66 of said judgment.
