The applicants are apprehending arrest in Crime
368/2018 registered with the Police Station Gadge Nagar,
Amravati for offence punishable under section 420 read
with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2] Applicant 1 is the father of Atul Lavhale and
applicant 2 – wife of Atul Lavhale, who concededly is the
main accused.

3] Atul Lavhale is absconding and for reasons
inexplicable the Amravati Police have not till date managed
to apprehend Atul Lavhale.

4] The material on record including the first
information report would reveal that *prima facie* Atul
Lavhale has indeed cheated the complainant.

The complainant was induced to pay a huge amount of Rs.74,90,000/- in cash to Atul Lavhale. However, the material on record including the first information report is *prima facie* not sufficient to connect the applicants to the crime. This of course a *prima facie* observation. The application is allowed.

5] The interim order dated 10.07.2018 is confirmed.
