By this writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order of the respondent no.4-Executive Council, dated 23.06.2017 rejecting the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order of his debarment.

Inter alia, the impugned order is challenged by the petitioner on the ground that the appeal is decided by the Executive Council without granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. It is submitted that it was necessary for the Executive Council to have heard the petitioner before deciding his appeal.

Shri Dharmadhikari, the learned counsel for the respondents, states on instructions that the petitioner was not heard before the appeal was decided and the Executive Council would take a fresh decision after hearing the petitioner.

In view of the statements recorded hereinabove, the writ petition is partly allowed and the impugned order is quashed and set aside. The Executive Council is directed to decide the appeal of the petitioner after granting an opportunity of hearing to him within six weeks. Order accordingly. No costs.
