No.496 of 1997, 539 of 1997 and 541 of 1997, which are the subject matter of challenge in First Appeal Nos.1184 of 2013, 1185 of 2013 and 1186 of 2013 which are already admitted, the present appeal, in my opinion, also needs consideration on the same line.
