1. Shri W.N. Nayse, Advocate states that Advocate Shri Kanungo is now looking after the matter and seeks time.
2. Heard Shri A.N. Ansari Advocate for original respondent No.3 and Shri R.R. Srivastava Advocate for the original appellant. Considering the nature of directions given in the judgment delivered in Appeal Against Order No.5/2018 on 4th April, 2018, in my view, the original respondent No.3 - Dharampeth Mahila Multi-State Co-operative Society can move the trial Court for redressal of it's grievance as made in this civil application.
