1. This is an application moved by the applicant-insurance company to deposit the decretal amount as per order dated 28.2.2018.

Verma for the applicant-insurance company submits that though there are lapses on the part of the applicant/insurance company to comply with order dated 28.2.2018, the lapses were not intentional and due to the procedural aspect, time required to comply with order dated 28.2.2018.
