This is an application for condonation of delay of 945 days in filing the appeal on behalf of applicant/appellant, who is claiming further enhancement of compensation over and above the amount of compensation granted by the Reference Court.

Applying the principle laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Imrat Lal and others vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others** {(2014) 14 SCC 133}, this application is allowed subject to condition that applicant/appellant shall not be allowed interest for the period of delay of 945 days if the appeal is allowed and compensation is further enhanced.
