Shri Daruwala, the learned counsel appearing for the respondent-husband has no objection if the petition-case E 304/2016 pending before the Judge, Family Court is decided in a time bound manner.

2] The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the petition unconditionally.

3] However, the learned Judge, Family Court is requested to finally dispose of petition-case E 304/2016 as expeditiously as possible and in any event within six months

from the date of this order.

as withdrawn.
