It is seen that a petition seeking a similar relief filed by the applicant has already been disposed of by this Court by an order passed on 20th August, 2018. From this order, it is further seen that the applicant has been given a liberty to challenge the ultimate penalty imposed, if any, and also to approach the appropriate authority for release of the vehicles

Since this application seeks a similar relief as claimed in the Writ Petition filed earlier, being Criminal Writ Petition No. 571 of 2018, disposed of on 20th
