In all these writ petitions, the petitioners are seeking for Mandamus directing the respondent to receive the Application Form CCPA dated 14.02.2018, 14.02.2018 and 15.02.2018 respectively with prescribed fees and grant the Maxi Cab Permit in respect of the vehicles bearing Reg.No.TN-20-BC-7601, Reg.No.TN-65-L-2967 and Reg.No.TN-02-AP-9904 respectively.

3. The grievance of the petitioners is that the respondent is not even receiving the application form for grant of Maxi Cab permit. 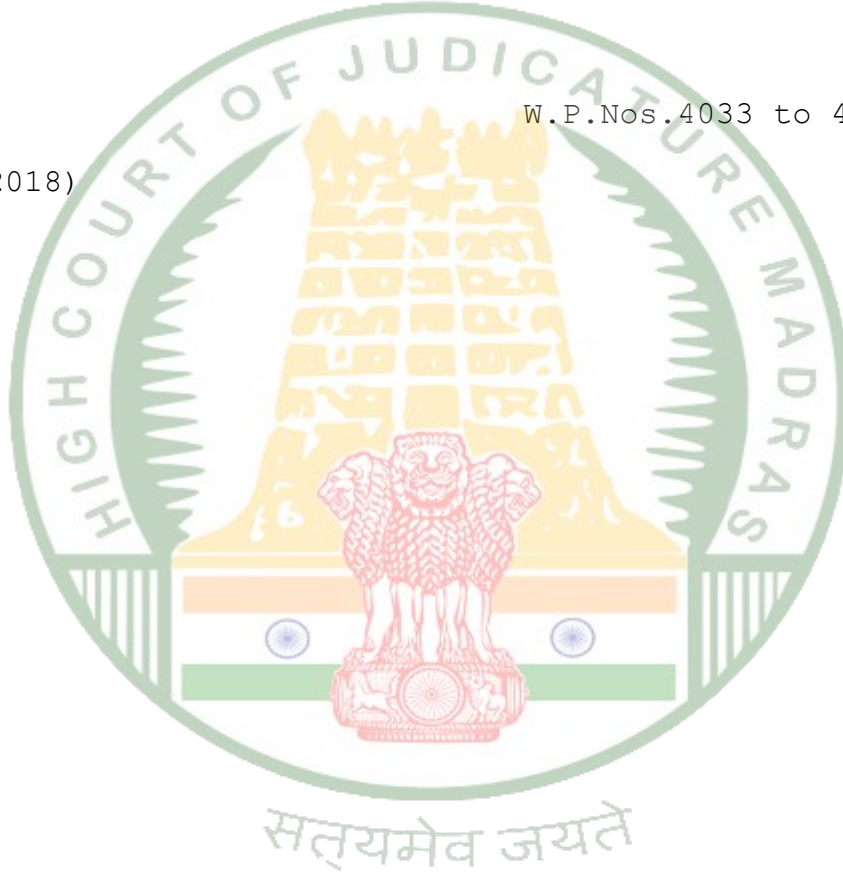
