COMMON ORDER

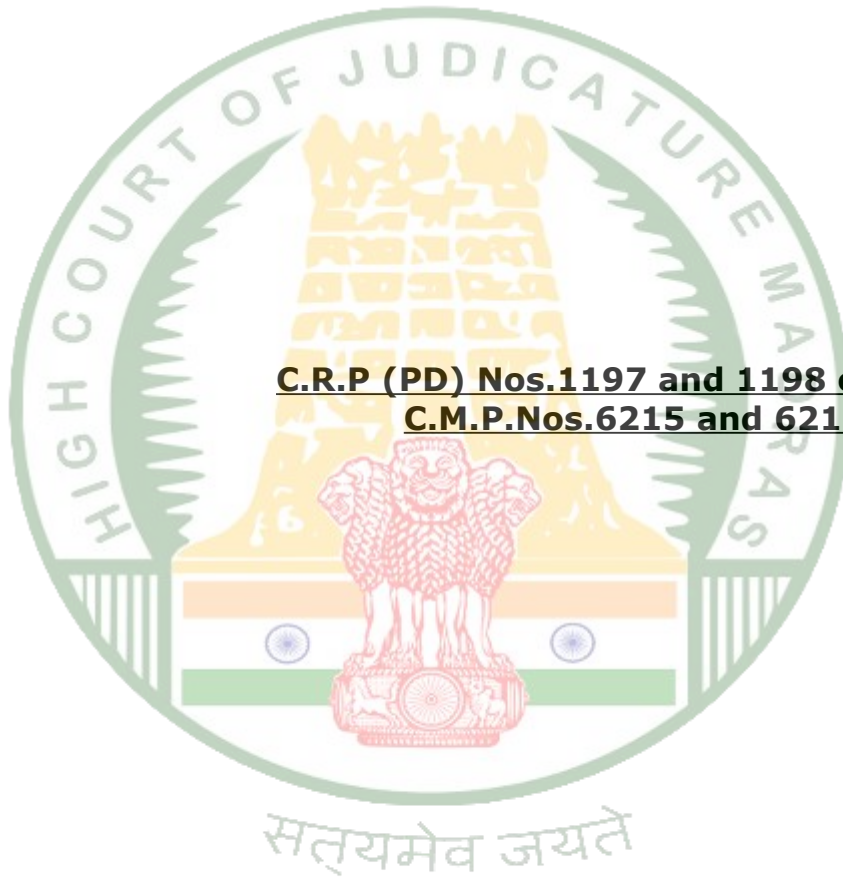
