2. When the matter is taken up, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor submits that the detinue has been secured. The detinue is produced before this Court. On enquiry, the detinue submitted that on account of some force exerted by her parents for her marriage, she went to her friend's house from where she was secured. Now, on enquiry, the detinue submits that she is willing to go with her father.

3. Recording the said submission of the detenue, the detenue is set at liberty. Accordingly, this habeas corpus petition is closed.
