This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking for a direction to respondents 2 and 3 to forward the further particulars to the 1st respondent herein for regularization of the purchase made by the petitioner under the Tamil Nadu Urban Land (Ceiling and Regulation) Act, 1978.

The petitioner said to have filed an application dated 16.05.2015, before the the 1st respondent seeking regularization of his purchase as per G.O.MS.No.565 Revenue [ULC1(2)] Department, dated 26.9.2008. 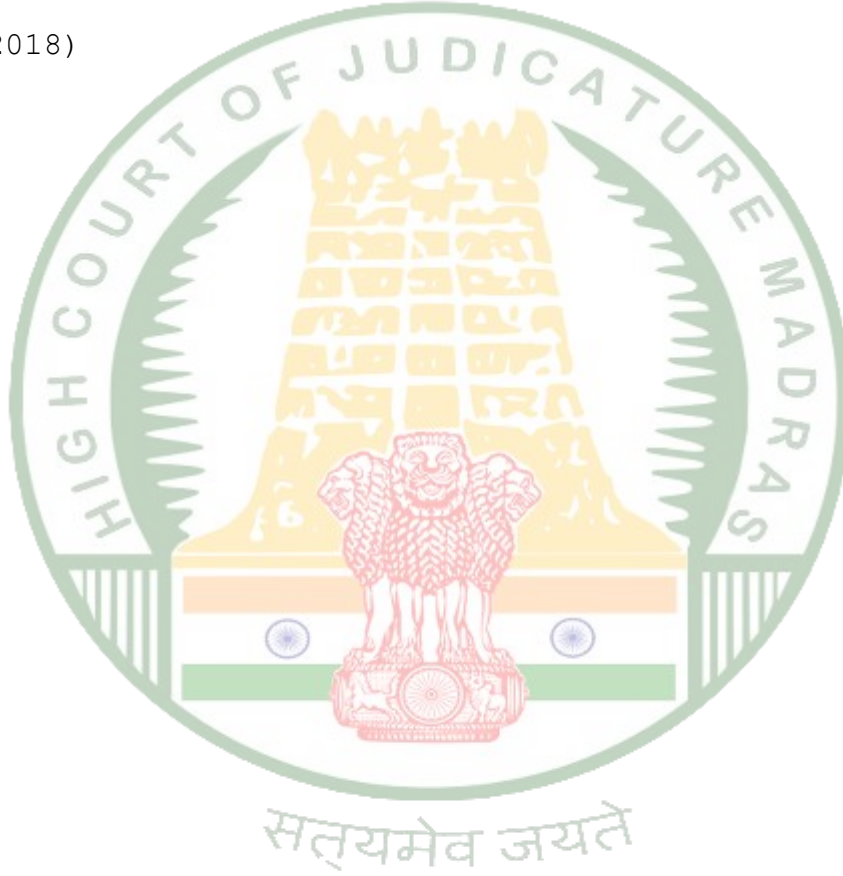
