ORDER

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner, the mother of the detinue, to produce the detinue, before this Court and set her at liberty.

2. When the matter is taken up, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor submits that the detinue has been secured and produced before the Magistrate. The detinue has made a statement before the police that on her own volition she has married one Dayanidhi and there was no inducement or threat or any allurement and that the marriage took place on 23.6.18. The detinue has further stated that she is living only with her husband.

3. Recording the said statement of the learned Addl. Public Prosecutor and finding that the detainee is not illegally detained, this habeas corpus petition is closed.

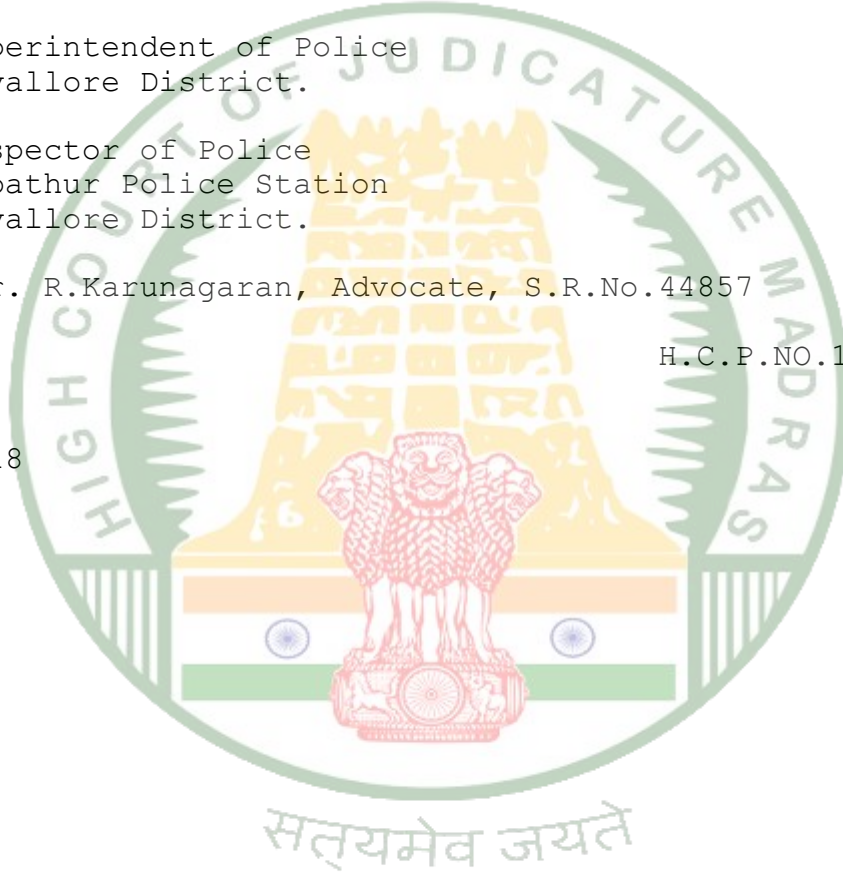
