Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and perused the materials on record.

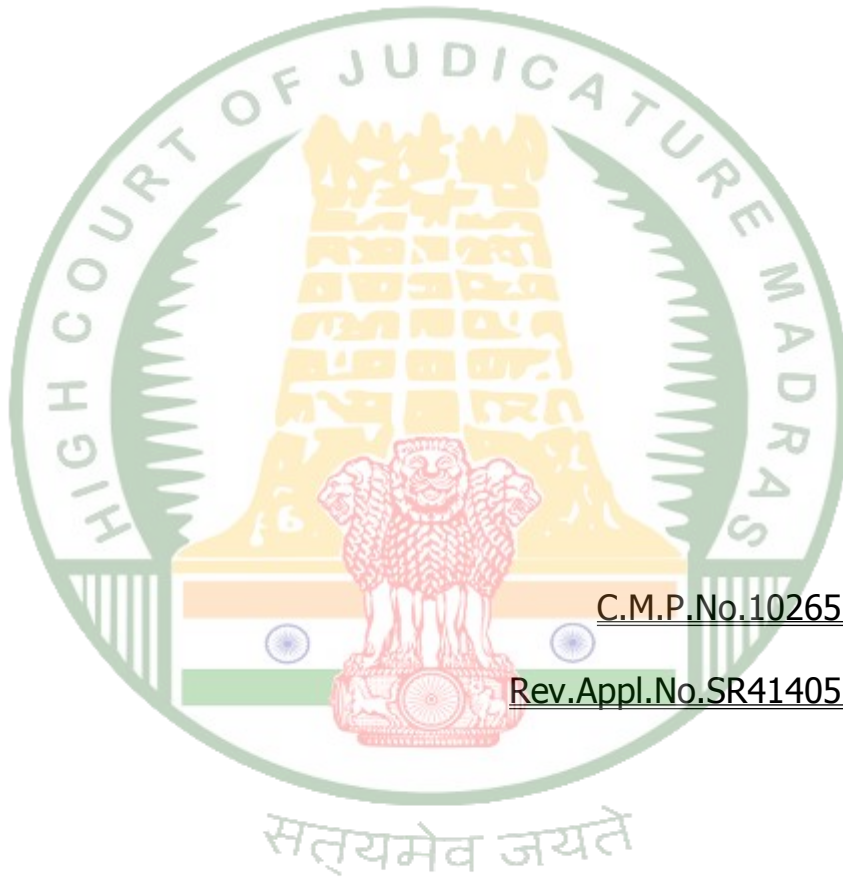
