ORDER

3.Today, when the matter is taken up, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents submitted that the order of this Court has been duly complied with by the respondents and the respondent has passed an order on 30.05.2017 rejecting the claim of the petitioner. He has also produced a copy of the proceedings dated 30.05.2017 issued by the respondents.

4.Since the order of this Court has been complied with, nothing survives in the present contempt petition. Hence, the Contempt Petition is closed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the order passed by the respondents in the manner known to law, if he so desires.
