The petitioner has filed the above Writ Petition to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider and pass orders on the representation dated 19.07.2018 made by the petitioner for the programme scheduled to be held on 10.08.2018 from 07.00 p.m. to 12 midnight.

2.It is the case of the petitioner that inspite of the representation being given to the respondents on 19.07.2018 for conducting cultural programme in the Temple on 10.08.2018, the respondents have not passed orders till today.

3.A Division Bench of this Court in W.P.(MD).No.3773 of 2017 by order dated 03.03.2017 in similar circumstances directed the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation and dispose of the same.

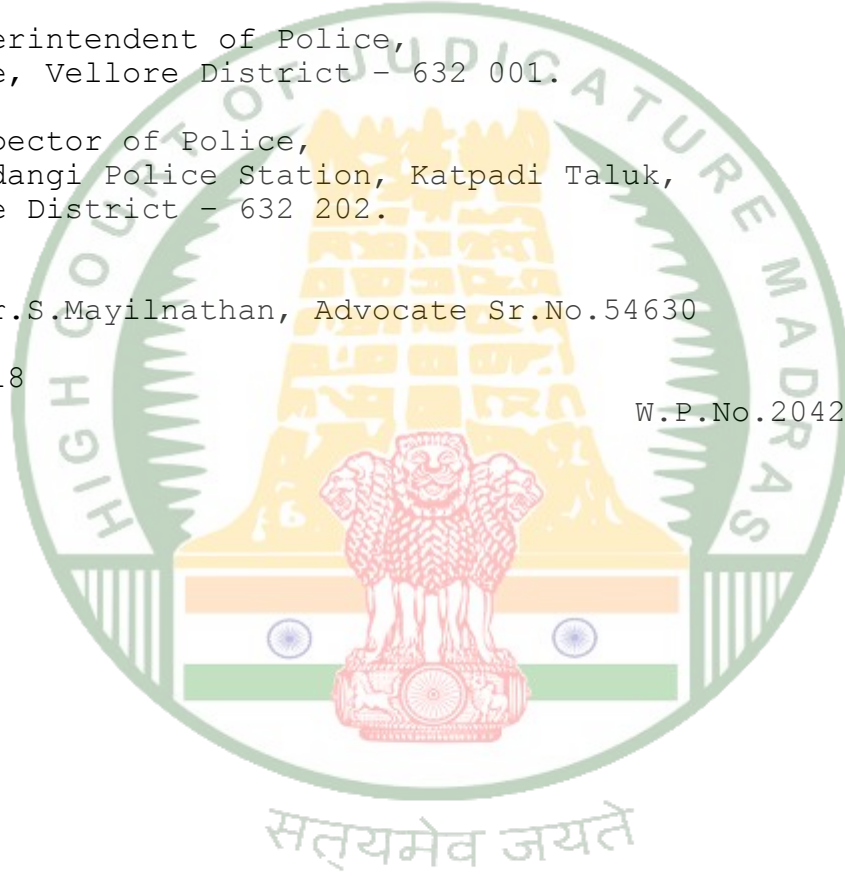
