ORDER

3. Thus, the Civil Revision Petition is disposed of with above direction. No costs.

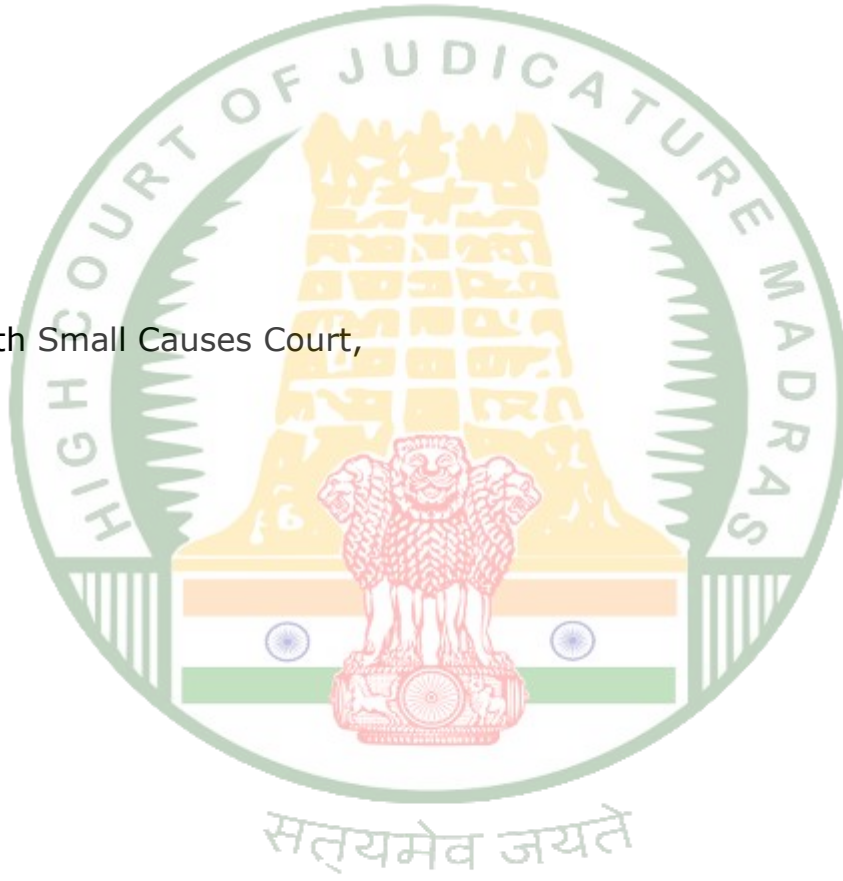

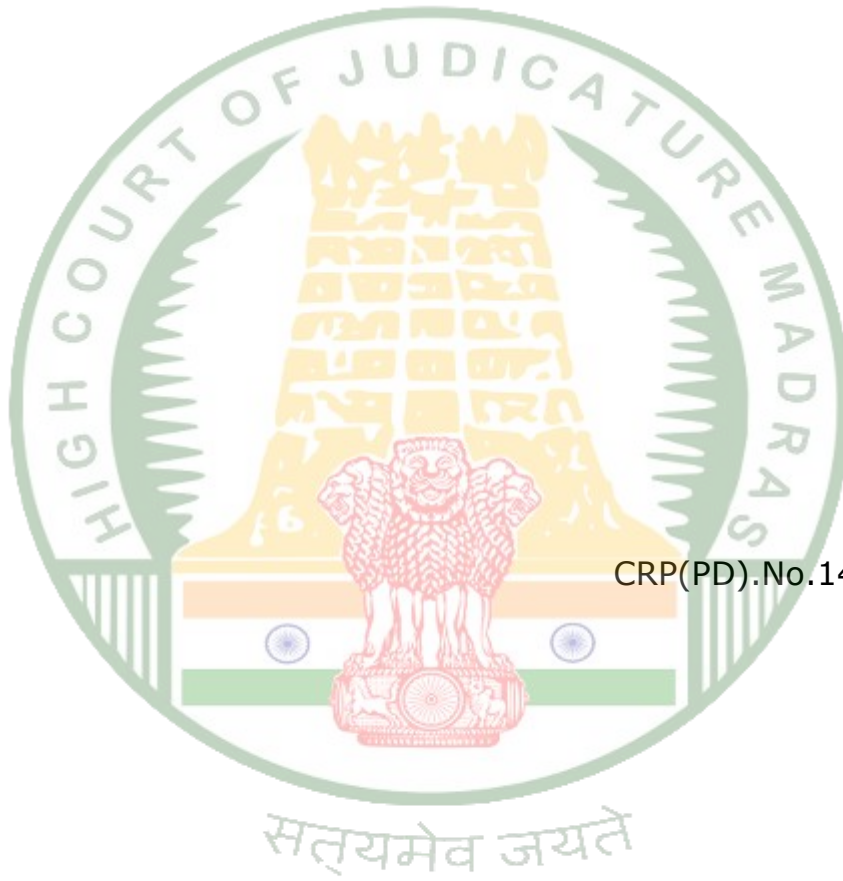
