2. The petitioner, being aggrieved by an order passed by the 2nd respondent dated 27.12.2016, rejecting his request to relocate the terminus from Tirupur Regional Stand to Tirupur Old Bus Stand, preferred an appeal before the first respondent Appellate Tribunal in Appeal No.25 of 2017.

3. The grievance of the petitioner before this Court is that the said appeal is not yet disposed of.

on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner as it is for the first respondent to consider and decide. 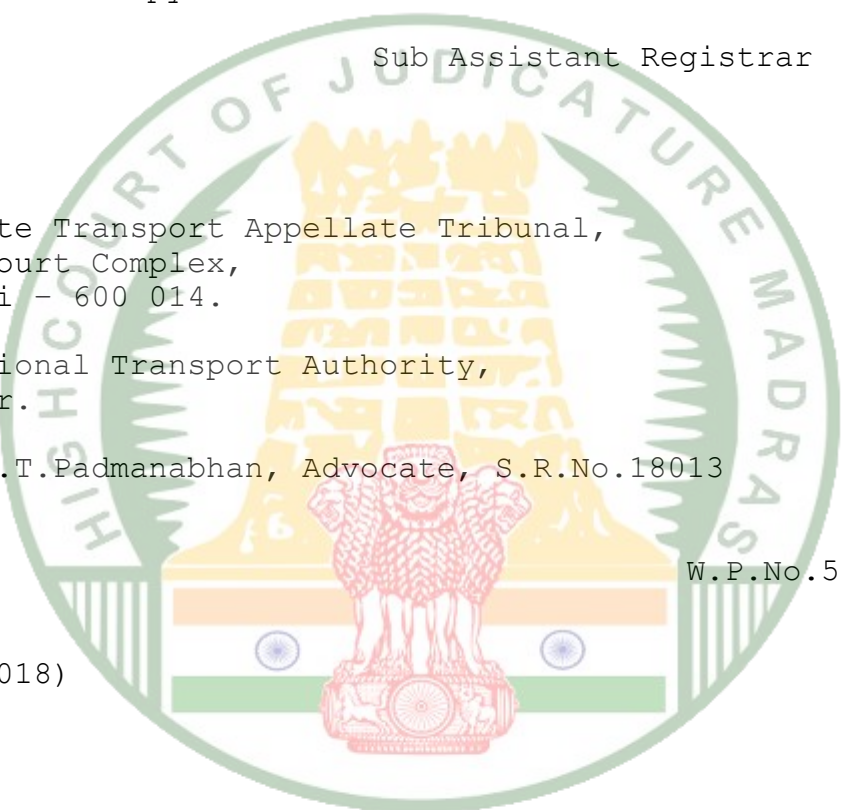
