This writ petition has been filed for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the fourth respondent to grant compensation in accordance with the Right to Fair compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 (30 of 2013) pertaining to the petitioners lands in new Survey No.106 B/1A2 and 112/1A1 measuring an extent of 240 sq.mtrs and 424 sq.mtrs respectively at Karanodai Village, Ponneri Taluk, Tiruvallur District.
