O R D E R

The learned counsel for the petitioner fairly made a submission that during the pendency of the writ petition, the Road Transport Corporation and Ministry of Highways, the Government of India, issued a Notification under Section 3A(1) of the National Highways Act for the purpose of widening the National Highways. Before the paper publication, the Notification was issued on 28.04.2018.

2.In view of the above development, the grounds raised in respect of the land acquisition proceedings initiated by the District Collector, Ramanathapuram has no significance. Thus, no further adjudication needs to be entertained in respect of the grounds raised in the present writ petition against the acquisition proceeding. If at all, any grievances exists for the writ petitioner, it is left open to him to adjudicate the matter in the manner known to law.

3.With these observations, the writ petition stands disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
