2. The petitioner seeks for a mandamus directing the respondent to consider his representation dated 28.02.2018, wherein and whereby, he sought for issuance of Patta in his favour in respect of the subject matter land.

4. The grievance of the petitioner before this Court is that the said request has not been considered by the respondent so far. This Court, at this stage, is not expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, as it is for the respondent to consider and decide the same. Thus, this writ petition is disposed of, only with a direction to the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated

28.02.2018 and pass orders on the same, on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the petitioner as well as the rival claimants and the other interested parties, if any. Such exercise shall be done by the respondent within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.

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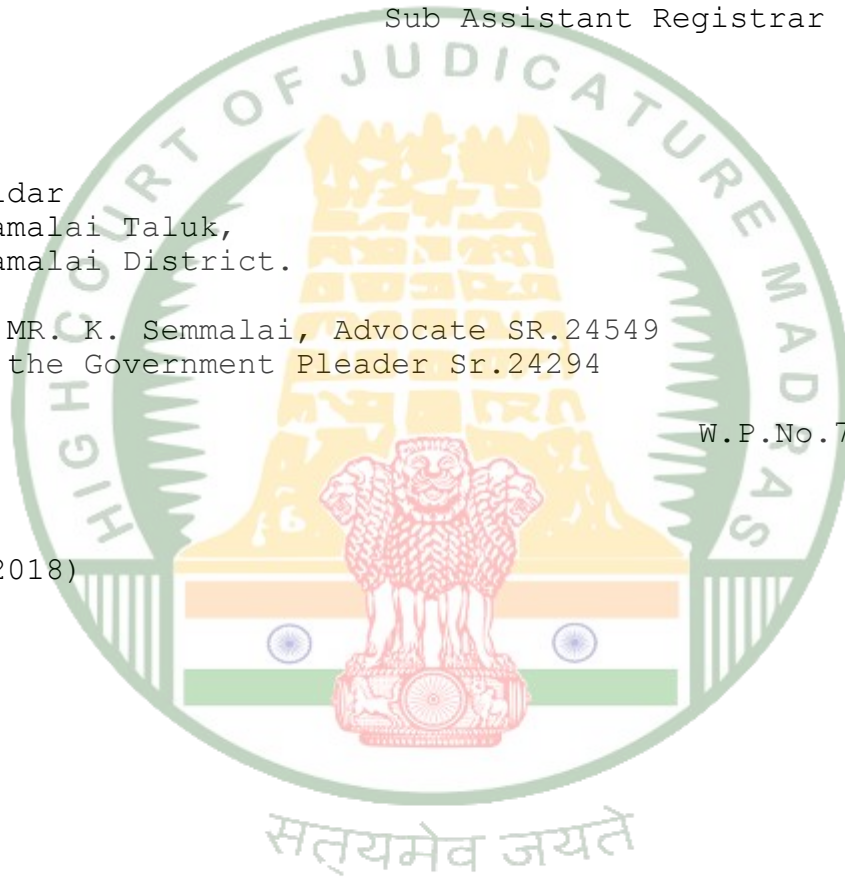
