Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Declaration, declaring the fixation of date as 01.04.1998 in Para 4 of G.O.Ms.No.174 Finance (Pay Cell) Department dated 21.04.1998 for availing gratuity and commutation as illegal, void, ultra virus, in so far as the petitioners are concerned, who had retired before 01.04.1998, and extend all the pensionary benefits to the petitioners on par with the pensioners who had retired after 01.04.1998 with interest at 18% per annum till the date of actual payment.

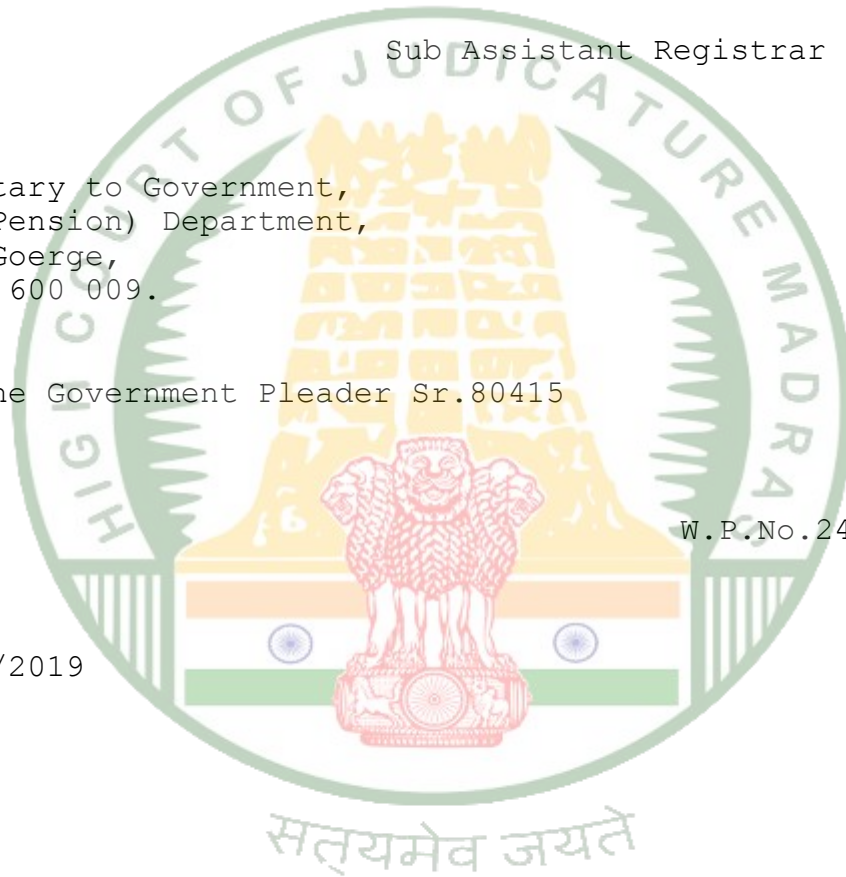
