(Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records of the first respondent having Ref.Na.Ka.No.2383 of 2002 Public Distribution Scheme dated 27.02.2004 and quash the same in so far as it directs the transfer of the ration shops from Thondappadi Primary Agriculture Cooperative Bank the second respondent herein to the R-58 Ariyalur Agriculture Producers Co-operative Sangam the third respondent herein, without the salesman and consequently, direct the third respondent to continue to engage the services of the petitioners as Salesmen of the ration shops on the same service conditions under which they were recruited initially with continuity of service and all other monetary benefits.)
