given by the petitioner, a petition enquiry in CSR.No.117 of

Court directs the respondent police to call both the parties and conduct enquiry and ensure that there is no law and order problem in the said land.

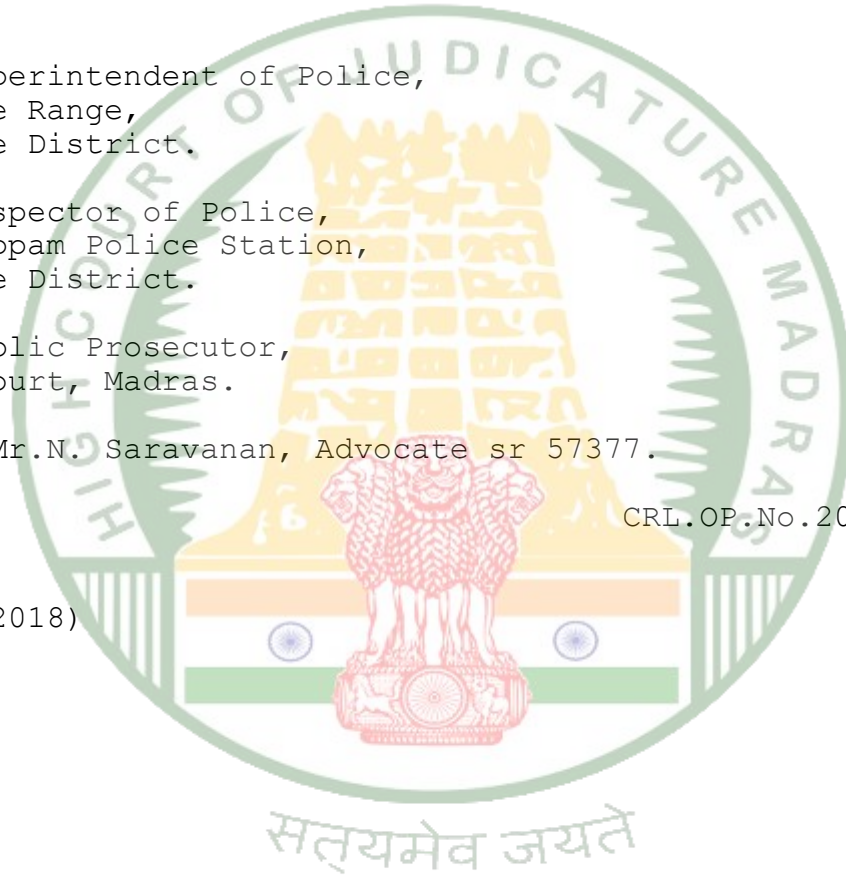
